

scholarships

ECU Village invites students to apply for the ECU Village Scholarship Program. Three scholarships (academic, arts and equity) are available to first year students who are enrolled in an undergraduate course of study at Edith Cowan University in 2017.

The ECU Village Scholarship Program will cover residential fees of up to \$1000 in value. The Scholarship Program does not cover additional fees such as utilities, application fee, security deposit or any other fees.

NOTE: Successful students will not personally receive the funding but will have their accommodation account credited by ECU Village.

eligibility

To be eligible to apply for an ECU Village Scholarship, students must:

- Be an Australian citizen or permanent resident;
- Provide evidence of financial hardship in the form of a Centrelink Income Statement (for the equity scholarship only);
- Have commenced full-time studies in a first year undergraduate course at Edith Cowan University in 2017; and
- Be prepared to enter into a residential agreement with ECU Village in 2017.

required documentation

All applicants will be required to attach the following:

- Copies of school reports for Year 11 and 12;
- ATAR ranking;
- Centrelink Income Statement (for the equity scholarship only);
- Evidence of Acceptance into Edith Cowan University; and
- A personal statement (maximum of 500 words typed) demonstrating what you hope to achieve during your University career, any extracurricular activities/work experience you believe will help you achieve your goals and why you believe you are a suitable candidate for the scholarship.

Candidate applications will be reviewed in line with the eligibility criteria and in addition, academic record including ATAR will be considered.

other eligibility criteria + conditions of entry

- All recipients of scholarships will be determined by ECU Village based upon the eligibility criteria outlined above and each of the following assessment criteria:
 - Financial situation
 - Academic achievement (based on provided high school grades)
 - Dedication to course of study (based on extracurricular activities, work experience, future goals etc)
 - Grammar and writing style
- Not all candidates meeting these criteria will necessarily be awarded scholarships.
- ECU Village reserves the right to not award scholarships in a year if no candidates are considered suitable by the scholarship selection panel.
- Successful students will not personally receive the funding but will have their accommodation costs paid directly by ECU Village.
- Scholarship recipients must be enrolled as full-time students and must reside at ECU Village for the year the scholarship has been awarded. Part-time and distance learning applicants are not eligible.
- Applicants must hold current Australian citizenship or permanent residency. ECU Village retains the right to be the final arbiter of an applicant's eligibility.
- If a scholarship recipient terminates their residential agreement with ECU Village, withdraws from their course of study, leaves university altogether or otherwise breaches the specific criteria of eligibility as listed above, their scholarship will be terminated with immediate effect and all rental payments ceased.
- Scholarships may be terminated if ECU Village determines the following:
 - Unsatisfactory academic performance (such as falling below the required academic standards to pass their course at Edith Cowan University)
 - The recipient acts in a way so as to bring Campus Living Villages Pty Ltd, ECU Village or Edith Cowan University into disrepute.
- Campus Living Villages and ECU Village may publish or publicise information, including winners' names, in mediums including but not limited to the University's website, the Campus Living Villages or ECU Village website and newspapers.
- ECU Village accepts no responsibility for any tax implications or impact to social security entitlements that may arise from the grant of a scholarship to a scholarship recipient. Applicants should seek independent financial advice prior to lodging their applicant for a scholarship.
